

THE SIGNATURE COURSE

Our specialist Signature Course gives you the confidence to create stunning coppers tones for your guests, working with depth and DOP (distribution of pigment in the natural hair) as well as those more complex colours and shades.

Our passionate students will learn first-hand about the vivid world of pigments and what an expert colourist requires to enhance or soften a colour. You will use swatches to create your own custom copper collection. As part of our exceptional education, we impart our knowledge and expertise on the science of copper and how to enhance natural copper hair too, as well as detailing the importance of good aftercare.

Another vital aspect of our Signature Course is understanding the colour wheel and we'll explore areas including complimentary colour, contrasting colour and pigmented colour as well as looking more closely at the colour wheel in the full format using the colour globe.

We'll investigate how to use cool and warm tones to create the desired lighter or darker shade. We will also learn how to enhance a natural copper using a range of products including vivid direct dyes and semis and glosses.

We'll delve deeper into opposite tones like violets and mushroom shades to create more daring variations of copper tones.

Another element of our course is to investigate dimensions of colour placement. This includes global creative colour and roots melts, whereby we look at skilful layering up of colour from complimentary to neutralising tones which can truly enhance your guest's hair.

Other areas we cover in our Signature Course include:

- How to convert blonde to copper as well as reds and brunettes to copper and the pros and cons to doing this method.
- Using different ranges of product types to create the best result from high lift to tinting.
- How to swatch using different coloured swatches and colour blending.
- A copper journey: how to map your guest's copper journey, exploring what the stages would be and how to map the plan using the copper's swatching sheet.





- Consultation: how to educate your guests in consultation including what they
 would need, what they need to bring and how to prep the hair prior to coming
 in.
- Getting the price right: we will discuss price transparency and how to manage high-maintenance colour and how to price effectively and fairly.
- Kits will include a swatch in kit from Pivot Point, a Copper Queen manual or guide and a kit from Yellow.
